It is a trial to see if it has a positive impact on students. All schools in the MAT are piloting this Big difference from other students in the year group is they start a day with CREW time – which is independent learning and the tutor coaches the students who are part of the trial SB suggested a separate agenda item with an update on this Gov asked how students were chosen? Andy informed that students had been invited to apply to be part of the pilot. They also asked how many were turned away – only a few did not get on the pilot We have cross curricular work taking place as shown on the handouts given and in the drive PSHE is learnt in most curriculum areas and there is work being done on evaluating how this is incorporated across the school – all curriculum areas will be doing this The ultimate aim of this process is to make our curriculum transparent SB said the pressure now is some faculties need to develop their planning further Governors were impressed with the work done on this and said this is good evidence for Ofsted to see a firm and common understanding of the curriculum Governors asked about new RS provision – RS was being delivered through one option subject as this was not taken up it is now running as twilight. It was agreed that SB would report on Behaviour, exclusions, attendance, successes, change in staffing for each meeting. 	New way of reporting - Direction of travel is against the strategic wheel and replaces rag rating, this will be done each term. SB said it was very powerful with his senior leadership team as it shows termly progress against our priorities. Governor asked if evidencing is tricky – SB confirmed we have been able to measure evidence in many ways and it has shown a better way for us to plan and evaluate and will be used in teams and could also be used for PIP measurement		
7.2	Attendance – started well – testing picked out 7 students who were asymptomatic and this then got worse and we had almost 20% of the school out. Staff were also hit heavy. This then picked up after half term but has dipped again recently. All of this is in line with national trends. Vulnerable groups are being supported. A governor challenged why 49.8% for LAC is so low - this was explained Some parents are requesting home education – these requests are deterred Staff attendance is good - we have recruited a further cover coach so we don't have to have as many supply teachers in school. We have also asked part time staff to come in on their days off to ease the burden on unfamiliar staff in lessons Recent science resignation but will be back filled by returning mat leave staff and a cover coach/instructor		
7.3	Behaviour measures – 93 on calls compared to 128/141 in previous years. Lots of work done in assemblies around expectations. A governor confirmed we are on top of students understanding our expectations – this was confirmed. We had a recent visit by Headteacher's who went round the school and behaviour was exemplary including Post 16 areas, also the case in the social area Governor questioned what levels of intervention model becoming embedded – this is checking the behaviour of student's/reports system/pastoral extended leadership meetings On Call checklist to make on call member of staff far more proactive around the building. There will be some staff training on 'on call referrals'
