## WHAT WILL I LEARN ON THIS COURSE?

The subject of History is undergoing some exciting changes, meaning you will have the opportunity to study some new topics covering at least 200 years of History. - Historical enquiry coursework unit with a focus on the Third Reich or the Holocaust.
