Introduction

Where It Can Lead To

The best jobs have traditionally gone to the best qualified, but now there is another dimension to recruitment. British companies who do more the 60% of their trade with the non-English speaking world are increasingly looking for graduates with more than one language. The modern economy is no longer a national, but a global one. There are very few British people able to converse in anything but English so employers are recruiting foreign graduates.
