Physical

- Bruises or marks
- Tender limbs
- Fear of adults
- Anti-social
- Unusual issues at school

Emotional

- Depression
- Hostility & stress
- Eating disorders
- Apathy
- Distant from parents

Sexual

- Inappropriate interest or knowledge of sexual acts
- Unstable moods
- Change in appearance

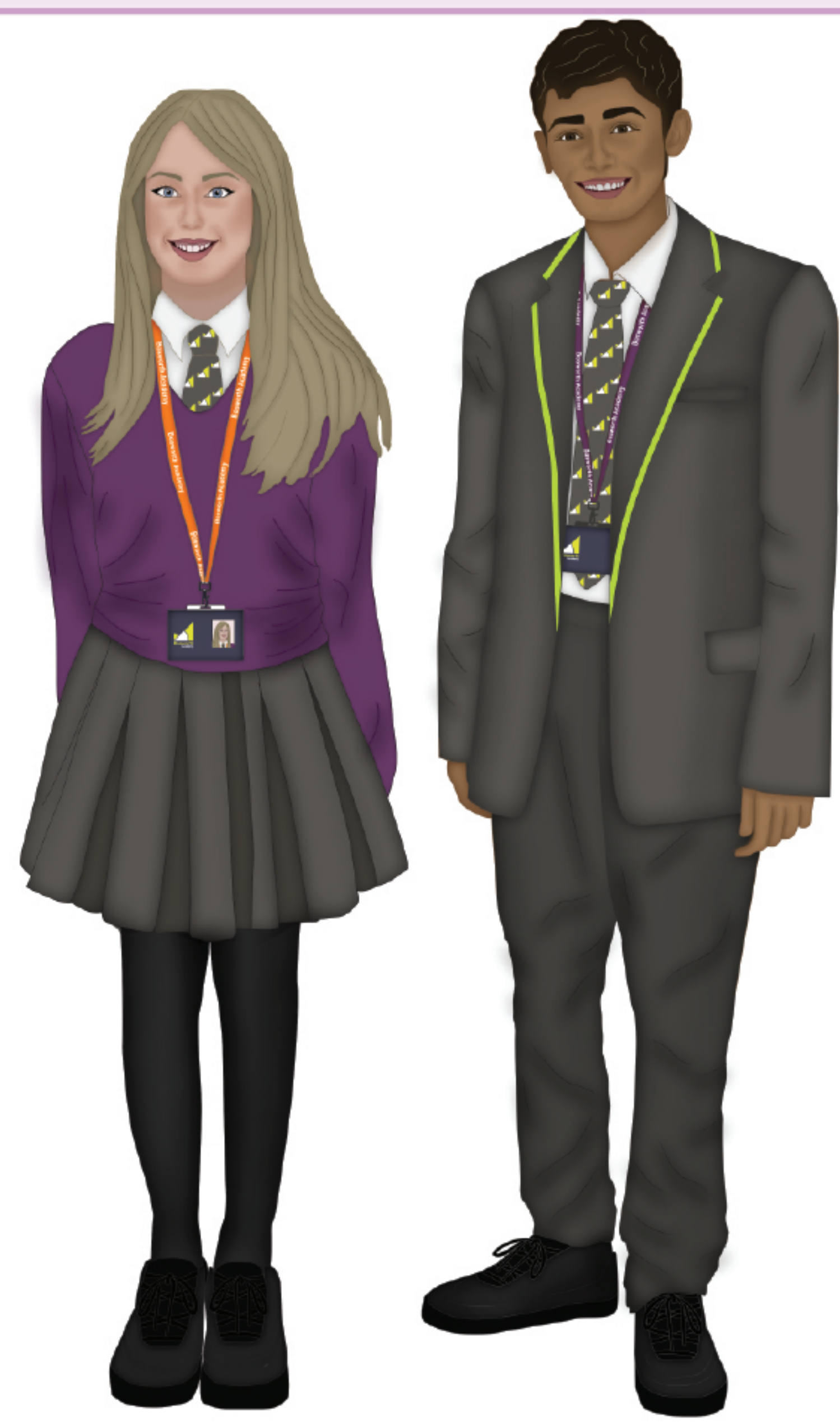
Neglect

- Poor clothing
- Hungry
- Dirty
- Poor supervision
- Tiredness
- Poor growth

Safeguarding children is our highest moral imperative. If not you, who? If not now, when?

Indications of Child Criminal or Sexual Exploitation (CCE or CSE)

- Unexplained money
- New Friendship groups
- Poor personal hygiene
- New clothes, hairstyles etc..
- Unusually tired



If a child makes a disclosure:

- Reassure them
- Don't promise confidentiality
- Don't ask leading questions
- Listen, note, date
- Pass to DSL or deputy via email or directly if it is urgent (dsl@bosworthacademy.org.uk)
