Dear Parent/Guardian & Laureate

On behalf of the entire Laureates team, I am absolutely delighted to welcome you to the Bosworth Academy family. Laureates is the name we give to our Key Stage 3 as we believe that everyone of our students is capable of exceeding their own expectations. A Laureate is *'a person who is honoured with an award for outstanding creative or intellectual achievement'*. This is exactly what we want for each and every one of our students at Bosworth Academy and our job is to help them achieve this.

It is always with great joy that we find out who is joining our school community and I can say with genuine excitement: we cannot wait to meet you later this year.

Starting secondary school is a major milestone, a fresh chapter filled with new subjects, new friendships, and new opportunities. At Bosworth Academy, we don't just focus on what you learn in a textbook; we focus on the person you are becoming. To help you navigate this journey, we use a framework called the 6Cs. These are the "superpowers" we want you to develop during your time with us:

- **Communication:** Sharing your ideas clearly and listening to others.
- **Creativity:** Thinking outside the box and finding new solutions.
- **Critical Thinking:** Questioning the world around you and making informed choices.

To make sure our school is a happy, productive place for everyone, we live by our "**Big-3**" rules. They are simple, but they are the secret to success at Bosworth:

1. **Be Kind:** This is our most important rule. A small act of kindness can change someone's entire day.
2. **First Time, Every Time:** When a member of staff gives an instruction, we follow it straight away. This keeps everyone safe and focused.
3. **Every Minute Counts:** Your education is precious. We arrive to lessons on time and ready to learn so that not a single second of your potential is wasted.

I know you might be feeling a mix of nerves and excitement right now. That is perfectly normal. Please know that we have a fantastic team of teachers and older students ready to support you from the moment you walk through our doors.
